Living in Peterborough

Peterborough is a vibrant city with plenty of things to see and do. In a recent 2015 poll Peterborough was named in top three best places to live if commuting to London

Peterborough is in the north west of Cambridgeshire bordering the counties of Lincolnshire, Leicestershire and Northamptonshire. Stamford is located 15 miles to the north of Peterborough.

Situated between East Anglia and the East Midlands, the city is at the centre of one of the fastest developing regions in Europe. It offers a wide range of housing, education, sporting, leisure, and commercial facilities. Here are some of the selling points of Peterborough City

- ➔ The city is only an hour on the train London
- ➔ The city has a direct link to Stansted Airport
- ➔ Variety of Shops and local market
- ➔ Multiplex Cinema/ Bowling alley/Rowing and outdoor sporting activities (sports centre next to the hospital)
- ➔ Beautiful Norman Cathedral/ Close to Rutland water – an area of outstanding natural beauty

Rent, Cost of Living & Commuting Time

The cost of living is quite low and affordable as a nurse if you're considering living in Peterborough According to the 2014 Lloyds Bank survey, Peterborough is in the top three when it comes to offering the best deal for commuting to London when looking at the difference between average house prices,

cost and time of commuting, and annual salaries.

The Lloyds Bank report states that the average house price in Peterborough is £182,114, whereas in central London buyers can expect to pay up to £722,000.

The average London salary is just under £47,000, meaning that people choosing to live in Peterborough and commute to London can buy a house for just 3.4 times their average annual earnings. The cost of rail fares for the travel was also relatively small



Finding Accommodation

There's a wide range of housing available in the city center and the surrounding townships of Orton, Bretton and Werrington. If you're looking for rented accommodation the range available is equally extensive. There are furnished city centre flats, bedsits and rooms. Because Peterborough is a growing city there are many new housing developments in the area. The new Hampton township currently under construction will provide a further 5,000 houses to the city

Sports & Leisure

Sports facilities include an all weather stadium for field and track events, squash courts, astro turf hockey pitch, tennis courts, several indoor swimming pools and a summertime lido, a parachuting and flying centre, gliding club, public and private golf courses, shooting clubs, cricket, rugby and football pitches and an ice rink.

Entertainment

Peterborough has plenty to offer for entertainment and nightlife. In the city center the Broadway area is the focus for a lively night out with late night bars and clubs.



Broadway also houses the Broadway theatre for live entertainment and cinema and the 13 screen Showcase cinema is situated just outside the city centre.

The Key Theatre, on the banks of the River Nene provides a wide range of live entertainment all year with a pantomime at Christmas. The Cathedral is used for many concerts and festivals with the week-long English music festival in July one of the summer highlights in the city's music calendar. Tolthorpe Hall, home of the Rutland Open Air Theatre and the popular Stamford

Shakespeare Company. Between June and August three Shakespearean plays are produced in the setting of a beautiful glade within grounds of the hall.

There are many local arts groups, amateur dramatics, operatic and musical societies.
