Living in
Macclesfield

East Cheshire NHS Trust is headquartered in Macclesfield on the edge of the stunning Peak District National Park. Surrounded by outstanding countryside and beautiful towns and villages, we are only an hour and 40 minutes from central London by train and Manchester International Airport is just a 20 minute drive away.

The town itself has a bustling and diverse community with a great choice of accommodation and a good range of schools. Major cities like Liverpool and Manchester are under an hour away and to the south east of Macclesfield are the Potteries and the historic counties of Staffordshire and Derbyshire. Our sites are well served by public transport links and we have excellent local amenities including a wide range of shops, parks and leisure facilities.

Macclesfield Town

Macclesfield is an ancient Market town nestling on the edge of the Peak District. A place of industry with a rich silk tradition and a current incarnation as a town with handsome buildings, great transport links, dynamic businesses and breathtaking countryside a short stroll out of town.

The Macclesfield Canal and River Bollin both run through Macclesfield, and the town is about 3 miles away from the beautiful Peak District and Macclesfield Forest.

There is also easy access via train to and from Manchester (Piccadilly - 16miles / 20minutes) or London (Euston - 146miles / 1hr 46 minutes) enjoy



Property & Travel

Poor silk weavers' cottages in the centre of Macclesfield have left the town with a rich property heritage. The borough of Macclesfield encompasses some of the wealthiest areas, not just in Cheshire, but in the country. If you want to live within 10 to 15 miles of premier footballer-rich Prestbury, Wilmslow and Alderley Edge but can't afford the property prices, then the town of Macclesfield is worth a look.

Situated at the foothills of the Pennines and on the fringes of the Peak District National Park, 20 miles from Manchester, Macclesfield is a typical market town in a fairly untypical location. The steep, cobbled streets allow tantalising glimpses of both the peaks of Derbyshire and the plains of Cheshire as you shop in Marks and Spencer's, New Look and Tesco's.

Seventeen miles from Manchester International airport and two hours from London on a non-stop Virgin train, Macclesfield is the acceptable face of 'up north', managing to be both comfortably middle class and with an ever so slightly 'rough around the edges' feel that is inevitable in a town that has always worked for its living.

Socialising

Unofficially, though, there are some who say the town of Macclesfield is perfect only for the under 17s and over 40s, due to the proliferation of questionable nightclubs and middle of the road restaurants that have sprung up over the last 10 years. But any town that complains there is too much to do for teenagers must be worth a visit. And as for those youths - a lot of the town centre is pedestrianised, which makes it easier for those too young to drive to stride out purposefully - and loudly - from shop to shop.



In that sense it's the same as any other town in England on a Saturday afternoon, except, in Macclesfield's case, the backdrop is a fabulous vista of green hills and rolling fields.

Travelling

Macclesfield is ideally placed for travel to London having a main line station in the centre of town and direct trains every hour. There are four trains an hour to Manchester, approximately 25 minutes away and two an hour to Birmingham. Road links are good with the M6, M56 and M60 all nearby.
